“Mask Up” Reminder from Audits and Investigations Unit

Dear Contractors:

The COVID-19 pandemic is not over, and the City’s laws for controlling the spread of the virus remain in effect. This is a reminder that **WITHOUT EXCEPTION**, all construction workers at a jobsite site **MUST** wear a mask at all times unless they are in the act of eating or drinking. Contractors, you are risking a \$2000 fine any time you or your workers fail to comply with the mask requirement.

Obey the law. Protect your wallet, your employees, and your fellow Philadelphians: make sure your workers are wearing their masks.
